

Bonnie Blanchard has long been respected in the Seattle area as a versatile freelance musician and a dynamic instructor of award winning students. She holds music and teaching degrees from University the Washington. She began playing flute when she was 19, and later engaged in a series of private instruction on piano, violin, viola, voice, and flute. A flute instructor for 35 years, Bonnie has had

the opportunity to work with many of the world's greatest flutists and teachers. Her creative ideas and unbridled enthusiasm for teaching have consistently produced students who win top awards in local and national contests and earn college and conservatory scholarships.
